

In October 2007, První brněnská strojírna Velká Bíteš, a. s. finished the implementation of the educational project

„Support of professional qualification of aerospace specialists through further training“

The project, co-financed from the European Social Fund and from the Czech state budget through the Ministry of Industry and Trade, resulted from higher requirements on proficiency of the Aircraft Technique Division personnel, associated with the Czech Republic's joining the European Union. The proficiency level is closely related to the Division's manufacturing activity, and directly influences competitive strength of the company.

Main objectives of the project included:

- improvement of the adaptability of the employer and employees – constructors, designers and technologists of the Aircraft Technique Division - to the changes in economic and technological conditions, and increase of their competitive strength;
- provision of specialized knowledge to employees;
- improvement of qualification and skills necessary for the employees to cope with occupational, structural and technological changes;
- extension of flexible forms of the organisation of labour, development of activities focused on the support to the occupational health and safety;
- development of positive approach to the environment;
- creation of a good practice model for next generations as a basic condition of sustainable development.

The implementation started on November 1, 2005. 23 training activities (68 trainings) were carried out within the project.
